

2025 Lem Si Ho Tong Society Scholarship and Awards

Definitions:

Scholarships are given to students with high academic achievements in the category to which they apply and are intended to provide incentive for further education. Awards are given to students or graduates in recognition of their scholastic achievements and participation.

Qualifications:

To qualify for a Lem Si Ho Tong (LSHT) scholarship or award, you must meet the following criteria:

- Enrolment in the 2024-2025 academic year in a recognized educational institution as:
 - a Grade 6 to 8 student enrolled in an Ontario elementary school during or;
 - a Grade 9 to 12 student in an Ontario high school; or
 - a full-time undergraduate student in College or University; or
 - a graduating student from College or University in 2025; and
 - A resident of Ontario with an updated LSHT membership registration; and
 - A fully paid member of the LSHT Society; and
 - Participation in at least two (2) LSHT event between August 01, 2024, and July 31, 2025; or being a volunteer on any LSHT Youth Committee activities between the above respective dates.
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- **Category 1 | Public School: Grades 6 to 8**
 - **Awards:** Up to three (3) students achieving a minimum average of 80%.
 - **Value:** \$200 each.
 - **Category 2 | High School: Grades 9 to 12**
 - **Awards:** Up to five (5) students achieving a minimum average of 80%.
 - **Value:** \$300 each.
 - **Category 3 | Full-Time College Undergraduate**
 - **Awards:** Up to five (5) students maintaining a minimum average of 70%.
 - **Value:** \$400 each.
 - **Category 4 | Graduating from an Ontario College or University**
 - **Award:** \$200 each.

Category 5 | Special Chinese Language Class Award

- **Award:** Presented additionally to students each year attending Chinese Classes while a fulltime student
- **Value:** \$100

Special Award: Elsie Lum Family Youth Recognition

- **Award:** An award presented additionally each year to the most deserving Youth Group Member.
- **Value:** \$200

All applications must be accompanied by:

- An original or officially school-certified academic transcript; and
- A letter of formal acceptance from an academic institution, such as a college or university, as required.

Omission of any of the above information will result in automatic disqualification.

The LSHT Board of Directors has ruled that all recipients of the LSHT scholarships and awards must personally attend the presentation ceremony to accept their prize. Those recipients who are absent from the presentation ceremony will automatically be disqualified. There is absolutely no exception to this rule.
